Responsibilities of the peer reviewer are to check for:

- 1. Overall impression of the article (Readability, flow)
- 2. Discipline based accuracy (facts and claim checks)
- 3. Content management (if there is any content that is not clear please flag that for the author)
- 4. To remark on all the aforementioned things on the manuscript addressed to the author.

As a Peer Reviewer, your job becomes important in cementing the validity and credibility of the manuscript received by you.

Things to note:

- -You do NOT make any changes to the article, ONLY suggestions based on the list mentioned above.
- -ALL changes, clarifications and suggestion need to be addressed to the authors (who will be anonymous)
- -Please note that you are part of a double blind procedure so you are anonymous to the author, and the author does not know who their peer reviewer is. Please maintain this confidentiality.
- You will only receive 1 manuscript and you will have the **duration of 5 days** to look over it before sending it back to the editorial team.
